This week is state wide tornado safety awareness. Today we participated in the state-wide drill. It is a good reminder to kids to ask them what their plan would be in the case of severe weather. If they are alone in the house what would they do if the siren's go off? Or if they are outdoors and they see lightning strike?

In 1968, there were many storms that hit Minnesota and flooding of the Mississippi and the Minnesota Rivers. I was 11 years old. We lived close to the Mississippi at the time and my dad helped sand bag. In the spring that year there was a night when many tornados went through Minnesota. One went over our house and they always say it sounds like a train? It does. A very, very loud train going right over your head. My dad was a boy scout leader and part of the troop was meeting that night in our basement. So, we had 10 boy scouts as well as my family huddled under blankets. The window blew out in our basement and thankfully we had the blanket as shards of glass were all over the blankets. I remember my little sister and brother crying and the rest of the kids were thinking this was a great adventure. I was brave especially in front of the boys of the troop! And shared the story in school.

After the storm, we had a tree on the roof of our house which only effected one corner. Some of our neighbors were not as lucky. I do remember it being a spring of storms. Our family remembers the night of the storm and shares the experience with each other. I thank God that we were all safe and will never forget the feeling of that tornado going over our house.
