Dear Families,

I must share with you something that has been driving me crazy all year. The lunch room. First, we have two racks of tables in the lunchroom that are in the way always! Giving us even less room in the lunchroom than we have. And the metal chairs....noisy and hard for the kids to move and sit on without slipping off them . Some of the little ones stick their feet through the back hole and then practically trip themselves trying to get out. Anyway, the lunchroom has been a major thorn in my mind this year.

Would you, your family, a parent or grandparent be willing to help us replace the tables with more kid friendly tables. And tables that could also be used by the funeral committee for funerals. They would have the round seats not bench style enabling older folks such as myself to sit on them with ease! We would put your family name on the table and any kind of a saying or biblical verse within reason on the plaque.

Each table would be around \$1500 with shipping. This comes to \$93.75 a seat! We need 8 tables (2 of which will be paid for by a CSCOE preschool grant.) So we are looking for about \$9000 to finish the project.

As you know we are totally tapped out in space. We don't even have an extra closet. This would give us some breathing room in the lunchroom. (the White tables can be stored in the on the storage areas for large events such as Apple fest).

If you can see your way to help with this project the kids would be so excited to have an actual school lunchroom with actual school lunchroom tables! Please consider this ask!

Dear friends of St. Anne's School

We're writing to share some great news that could be a major benefit for students across Minnesota and for our school -- and to ask you to make an importance difference by contacting your elected officials TODAY.

Legislation that would be a major breakthrough for school choice in Minnesota is on the doorstep of becoming law. A provision called the **Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit** has been included in the House and Senate tax bills that have passed both legislative bodies. The Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit allows for individuals or corporations to make a donation to a non-profit that would grant scholarships for students to attend a private school of their family's choice. The donations would be eligible for a 70% state tax credit. This will make a big difference in eliminating financial barriers that prevent some families from having their children attend the best school for them.

We need to encourage legislators to continue to support this important provision and urge Governor Dayton to sign the Opportunity Scholarship tax credit into law once it reaches his desk.
